2021 STALLION BREEDING CONTRACT - ROYAL SUGAR FLIT

This STALLION BREEDING CONTRACT for the 2021 breeding season is made and entered into on this ____ day, of _____, 20____ is by and between Traci Pratt and/or Rockn T Quarter Horses, hereinafter-designated Breeder / Stallion Owner, and _____, hereinafter designated Mare Owner. Mare Owner agrees to breed the mare, _____ Reg. No. _____ to the stallion, ROYAL SUGAR FLIT Reg. No. 3943711 for the stallion fee of \$1500.00, for a live foal, subject to the following conditions. Stallion fee includes a non-refundable booking fee of \$500.00, payable with this contract. The balance must be paid in full before semen is shipped or mare is bred. Please make fees payable to Traci Pratt.

The Stallion Owner's Stallion Station, hereinafter designated RCES, for the 2021 breeding season is: Rock Creek Equine Services, 8459 Rock Creek Road, Waco, TX 76708; clinic (254) 752-3725, Fax: (254) 752-8473, Email: Piggin_String@yahoo.com. The breeding season will be February 15 thru June 15 unless otherwise approved by Stallion Owner. Live cover/pasture breeding will be an option in some circumstances. If you are interested in LIVE cover, you must contact and coordinate with Stallion Owner.

Cooled Shipped Semen

1. The first collection, chute fee, and shipping fee is included in the stallion fee. Should additional collection and shipping be required, the fee is \$350.00 per shipment. (There are additional charges for shipments outside the United States.)
2. RCES requires notification from Mare Owner or Mare Owners Veterinarian prior to 8:00 A.M., Central Standard Time on the day you need the semen shipped. In the unlikely event of insufficient semen on any particular breeding day, RCES reserves the right to determine which mares will be bred, based on reproductive status and early notification.
3. Normal shipping days for RCES are: Monday, Wednesday and Friday. RCES will ship semen "overnight" using Fed Ex or UPS and semen normally reaches destination before noon the following day. In the event Mare Owner requires delivery on a Saturday or a Holiday we ask that the Mare Owner check with their local office to ensure that they do deliver to your location on weekends and that your veterinarian does receive shipments on weekends. Airline Counter-to-Counter service is available for an additional courier fee.
4. Mare Owner shall file a credit card with RCES for billing any late penalties or costs due to lost or damaged containers. No deposit for shipping containers is required by RCES. Mare Owner is advised to purchase insurance on containers.
5. Mare shall be checked to be in healthy and sound breeding condition by a veterinarian. Any previous breeding problems shall be disclosed to RCES and Breeder. Mare Owner agrees to diligently try to settle mare; however, if mare fails to settle for any reason, Mare Owner will hold RCES and Breeder blameless. Mare Owner is required to have mare ultra-sounded by a licensed veterinarian 14-20 days after being bred and said results shall be sent to Breeder. Any mare not ultra-sounded within 20 days after being bred shall make the "Live Foal Guarantee" null and void. Mare must be rechecked and confirmed pregnant at 45-60 days into gestation.

Breeding Farm

1. RCES agrees to provide suitable facilities for the care and feed of the mare and/or foal while in this custody. Mare Owner should contact RCES to arrange for mare care.
2. RCES will exercise judgment consistent with recognized standards in care and supervision of mare and/or foal. Breeder assumes responsibility for arranging veterinarian and farrier services as necessary. Breeder's veterinarian will examine mare for normal breeding complications and administer medical care as deemed necessary for the health and safety of the mare and/or foal. RCES encourages Mare Owner to have insurance on the mare while at RCES.
3. The mare shall be in healthy and sound breeding condition, free from infectious, contagious or transmissible disease. Mare must be current on all vaccinations. Mare Owner shall provide a current negative Coggins Test and copy of registration papers (both sides). If negative Coggins is not supplied, RCES will test at the expense of Mare Owner. Mares not halter broke will NOT be accepted. If a mare is refused, the booking fee shall constitute liquidated damages. Mare Owner agrees to make RCES aware of any vices mare may have, included but not limited to: kicking, biting, bolting, etc.
4. Breeder agrees to diligently try to settle mare; however if mare fails to settle, for any reason, Mare Owner will hold Breeder and RCES blameless. Mare Owner must leave mare with RCES until mare is pronounced safe in foal, to insure "Live Foal Guarantee". If Mare Owner chooses not to leave mare with RCES after the mare has been bred then it will be up to the Mare Owner to have the mare ultra-sounded by a licensed veterinarian 14-20 days after being bred. The results shall be sent to the Breeder. Any mare not

ultra-sounded within 20 days after being bred will make the "Live Foal Guarantee" null and void. Mare must be rechecked and confirmed pregnant at 45-60 days into gestation.

Frozen Semen

1. Frozen semen is available. Please contact RCES for shipping costs.

General Conditions

1. This contract contains a "Live Foal Guarantee". A live foal is described as a newborn foal, which stands and nurses without assistance. If foal is born dead, there are return privileges for the following breeding season only if Breeder is notified within 30 calendar days and receives a veterinarian's statement confirming death. If after being pronounced "safe in foal", the mare should miscarry, abort or prove barren, Mare Owner has the privilege to return her for breeding during the current breeding season or the following year. Mare owner shall be responsible for all cost (collection and shipping fees) associated with rebreeds.
2. A "Breeders Certificate" will be issued for the foal conceived by this mating when stallion fee and all other expenses have been paid in full; and when Breeder has been notified by Mare Owner that the mare has produced a live foal by this mating.
3. It is further agreed that should the stallion die, be sold by the owner, or become unfit for service prior to settling the mare, this contract shall become null and void and the breeding fee shall be returned. If notified in writing by a licensed veterinarian that the mare has died or become unfit to breed before pronounced safe in foal, the Breeder may accept a replacement mare upon evaluation and approval of Traci Pratt.
4. This Contract is non-assignable and nontransferable. This Contract is entered into in the State of Texas and will be interpreted and enforced under the laws of that state. This Contract represents the entire agreement between parties. No other agreements or promises, verbal or implied, are included unless specifically stated in this written Contract. When Mare Owner and Breeder sign this Contract, it will then be binding on both parties.
